According to Congressman Dan Lungren, the **“Folsom Joint Federal Project project will only provide a level of flood protection equal to that of New Orleans before Katrina hit.** Auburn Dam combined with the JFP would provide between 400 to 500 years flood protection and must be considered. To avoid the escalating cost increases due to the rising cost of materials, the **Auburn Dam project should be formally evaluated as soon as possible.”**
